Instructions (Applicants/Senior Naval Science Instructors)

- 1. Visit our website: https://navalscience.umbc.edu/
- 2. Click the "Forms" tab on the left side of the screen.
- 3. Applicants: Download the Presidential NROTC Preparatory Scholarship application form, save the form locally to your computer.
- 4. Senior Naval Science Instructors: Download the Senior Naval Science Instructor recommendation form, save the form locally to your computer.
- 5. Open the forms in Adobe Reader. Adobe Reader is available free from this website: https://get.adobe.com/reader/
- 6. Start typing your information into the document. Note: write your essays in Microsoft Word first so that you can spell check them. Then, cut and paste them into the application. Max allowed essay length is approximately one page, single-spaced in Microsoft Word. Ensure your entire essay is visible in the form when printed.
- 7. Save frequently as you work. Be sure to save the final version to your personal storage device.
- 8. When complete, print and sign form using pen.
- 9. Applicants: Scan the signed document and forward it along with all other required documents (see checklist above) to mgrenier@umbc.edu.
- 10. Senior Naval Science Instructors: scan and send signed document to mgrenier@umbc.edu.

15JAN19 – Applicants will be notified if they are selected for interview.

03FEB20 – 14FEB20 – Interviews will be conducted.

21FEB19 – Scholarship awardees will be notified.
